

In this class, you'll make a chenille Santa wall hanging for the holidays.

You'll learn how to work with the new 'faux chenille' tape to make Santa's beard. With this fun product, you can give your quilts a vintage look on a shabby chic style quilt, trim a jacket or bag, or make a 'snow' man runner.

This class is for all skill levels - a fun and easy project for the holidays.

The kit for this class will contain the pattern, prewashed red fabric (to guarantee that Santa doesn't end up with a pink beard his bath), fusible grid for the hat and chenille tape in two sizes for the beard. The price for this kit announced when made up in September and will be collected at the class.

A complete supply list will be posted in September. You could be on the lookout now for Santa's spectacles and bells you would like to use to trim the hat. You will also learn how to make a chenille pompom for the hat if you decide this is what you prefer. In class you will also receive a page of the templates for the snowman runner but there is no actual pattern for the runner.
